Ski and Binding Selection For Kids and Teens

There are significant differences between skis and boots designed for kids and teens who are generally not as tall, strong or as heavy as adults. Please see the criteria below:

1/ Junior Skis:

- Length should be 170 cm or less
- Usually labelled "Team", "Jr" or similar
- Narrower profile (width) than adult skis

2/ Junior Bindings:

- Check binding setting range on toe piece

<u>Weight</u>	<u>Binding Range (DIN)</u>
Kids under 80 lbs (35 kg)	.75 – 4
Kids over 80 lbs (35 kg)	2 – 7
Adult (Recreation)	5 – 10
Adult (Performance)	7 – 14

3/ Junior Boots:

- Sizes up to Size 5 for Junior Boots
- 2 – 3 Buckles on Junior Boots
- 4 buckles on Junior Race Boots
- 4 or more buckles on Adult Boots
